PENGUIN BAY WINERY WINS TWO GOLD MEDALS AT CALIFORNIA'S INTERNATIONAL EASTERN

Hector, NY – February 23, 2015 – Penguin Bay Winery, located on the Seneca Lake Wine Trail, is thrilled to include two gold medals to its accolades from the recent International Eastern Wine Competition in Sonoma County, California.



The International Eastern stands as one of the oldest and longest-running wine competitions in the nation which began in 1975. Last year, for the first time, the competition expanded to create the International "East Meets West" Wine Challenge where it was combined with the West Coast Wine Competition. After a successful year, the two competitions continued this new tradition and awarded 1164 wines.

Penguin Bay was awarded with six medals total including two bronze, two silver and two gold. The gold medals went to the 2013 Vidal Blanc Ice wine and Percussion, a semi-dry white blend. This is the second gold medal awarded to each of these wines, with the 2013 Vidal Blanc Ice also winning a double gold medal at the 2014 Jefferson Cup (MO) and the Percussion winning a gold medal at the 2014 NY Wine & Food Classic.

Penguin Bay Winery, owned by the Peterson Family, is located on Route 414 in Hector, NY. The tasting room is open year round with winter hours in effect until April and features a fun variety of dry to sweet white and red wines in addition to a selection of sparkling wines produced by sister wineries, Swedish Hill and Goose Watch.
